Content	Medical education for export in Kyrgyzstan has many challenges in the way of achieving international standards. A recent case of blacklisting Kyrgyzstani medical HEIs by Pakistani Medical Council (PMC) has several reasonable roots, and made visible different problems and aspects of the phenomena of medical education for export in Kyrgyzstan. Then 4 HEIs were removed from the black list, but misconducts and failures of both sides - Pakistani and Kyrgyzstani controlling authorities, underlying the case are still to be corrected.
