Content	AFRI-VIPE originated from VIPE: Virtual Interprofessional Education. VIPE is a collaborative of several universities in the United States: Yale, NYU, USC, GW, and Georgetown who initially came together in 2017 out of the need to give their students an IP experience. All of our programs are online. We recognized that we all had a shared interest in IPE and volunteered to be a part of this committee. We hosted our first VIPE in 2018 giving students asynchronous content and synchronous opportunities. We were accepted to present at the 2nd IPE and collaborative practice for africa in summer 2019 in Nairobi, Kenya. From there many conference attendees expressed interest in creating a similar initiative throughout Africa. From there we created AFRI-VIPE which was held during the height of the pandemic to include 399 participants, 27 universities and 29 different healthcare professions.

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
