Content	<p>Objective: Promote health using audiovisual techniques, short videos, and educational activities to empower children, adolescents, and their caregivers in the care of their individual and collective health. Method: The most relevant health problems are prioritized in each population, in kindergartens, a population from 0 to 5 years old, and teenagers, involving parents, teachers, and administrators of each institution. Prioritized topics are developed by medical students who design and create audiovisual material, blogs, videos, and games to promote health according to the target population, children, youth, or adults and the problem to be addressed. The session is implemented including the participation of the public with games, videos, and discussions, which encourages interaction and appropriation of knowledge. Agenda: Since 1980, the Department of Community Medicine has created several strategies to approach the community through effective programs, involving not only the academic community but also diverse community actors; taking into account their needs and specific age groups, including early childhood and adolescence. Understanding and prioritizing their needs in favor of multisectoral programs that give them adequate answers to their problems. Results: The populations intervened have been able to manage individual and collective solutions for the prioritized problems, with the support of medical students, children, institutional actors, and parents. The results of the program are measured monthly and approximately 80 children between 0 - 18 years old and their families benefit. Conclusion: virtual knowledge methods have been a useful tool to teach, learn and integrate different stakeholders around a topic to give efficient solutions.</p>
